I wish to convert the class(es) listed above to Pass/Fail. Initial each line:

- I understand that a grade of C- converts to "P" (Pass); that a lower grade converts to "F1" (Fail), and that "P" and "F1" are not computed in GPA.
I understand that Pass/Fail courses generally do not count toward a major, a minor, or an interdisciplinary minor.
I understand I may only pass/fail a D or D+ grade if I am ahead of normal progress with respect to graduation, as pass/failing a D or D+ grade results in an F1 final grade and a loss of course credit.
I understand that some medical schools and others insist that certain courses required of applicants be taken for a grade. I understand that LSDAS, the law school admissions service, and CASPA, the physician assistants service, computes P/F failures (F1) as grades of "F" in figuring GPA. I understand that Phi Beta Kappa requires a minimum of 18 graded courses by the end of fall semester senior year. For the classes of 2021, 2022, and 2023 Phi Beta Kappa will only require 16 graded classes.
I understand that my choice of Pass/Fail grading may never be revoked. I also understand that once the change has been made, the original grade does not appear on the transcript and cannot be sent by the Registrar's Office to a grad school or elsewhere.
I understand that I may not designate a course Pass/Fail if a final grade of F has been assigned as the result of an Honor Code sanction.
