Sometimes courses are taught under two departments. If you see a title like this, it means REGISTER for CRN 14195 and do not use its CRN, 14196.

This is the Course Reference Number. It is what you will enter into WebTree when selecting courses.

This is the course section. Some courses are offered at multiple times during a single semester, and you can choose whichever works best for you.

This is a course with a lab component. Each lab and lecture section have the same CRN, which you'll use when you enter the course into WebTree.

Be sure to check the Notes section to see if a class has any restrictions. For example, a 12+ notation means the course is only open to first- and second-years until the first day of classes. Hover over each note for further explanation.

These three columns show the maximum number of students, the number of students currently enrolled, and the number of open spots remaining for each course.

This column explains which Ways of Knowing (general education) requirements are fulfilled by each course. Students must take courses representing seven different areas, represented by codes in this column.

This is the instructor. If you see a course with "Staff S" as its instructor, it means the course is being offered but does not yet have a professor assigned.
