Rights and Responsibilities of the Student

- A student with a disability at Davidson College has the right to request reasonable accommodations ensuring equal access to courses, course content, programs, services and facilities available through the college by contacting the Office of Academic Access and Disability Resources.
- A student has the right to confidentiality with regards to their disability(ies) and restricted disclosure of information except when required or permitted by law.
- A student has the right, if he or she believes they have been treated unfairly, to file a grievance with the Dean of Students Office.
- Although students are not required to disclose their disability status, if they are seeking accommodations relative to their disability, they are responsible for providing current and appropriate documentation to the Office of Academic Access and Disability Resources.
- A student seeking accommodations is responsible for providing the Office of Academic Access and Disability Resources with a written request for accommodations each semester.
- The student is responsible for contacting their instructors about their accommodations and for making arrangements with their instructors ahead of time.
- The student is responsible for letting the Office of Academic Access and Disability Resources know if there is a dispute with an instructor about their accommodations or the implementation of them.
- A student has the responsibility to meet qualifications and maintain essential standards for all course, programs, services, jobs, activities, conduct and facilities. The college seeks to accommodate students in a manner that is determined to be reasonable and that does not compromise the integrity of the curriculum.

Conditions of Use for Authorized Recordings

Students approved for an accommodation related to audio or video recordings of class are subject to the following conditions of use:

- Authorized recordings will be used solely for the purpose of class notes for individual study. Students will not use the recordings or allow them to be used for any other purpose.
- Students will not reproduce (other than transcription solely for the student's own use as class notes), distribute, or sell the recordings or information contained therein.
- Students will not allow authorized recordings to be reproduced, sold, or distributed in any manner to any other person(s).
- Students will destroy all recordings at the end of the course.

Agreement and Consent

I understand and agree to file the appropriate documentation with the Office of Academic Access and Disability Resources indicating that I am entitled to receive academic accommodations. I understand and agree to the rights and responsibilities listed on Page 1 and the conditions of use for authorized recordings (if applicable) and that I play a central role in receiving accommodations.

By signing this agreement, I will allow the Office of Academic Access and Disability Resources and Dean Jason Shaffer to use or disclose confidential information in order to provide me with accommodations. Davidson College will disclose information regarding my academic accommodations only when necessary to advisers, faculty, and staff who have a need to know.

I understand that I must request a renewal of my academic accommodations each semester that I want to have them and indicate which professors should receive a Professor Notification regarding my academic accommodations.
