APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Thank you for your interest in Davidson. We are pleased that you are applying for admission and look forward to working with you throughout the application process.

Davidson's admission process is highly selective, which means we enroll students who have academic potential and the motivation to succeed. The application process is designed to allow you to demonstrate your intellectual curiosity and personal achievements and your desire to learn. We seek evidence of academic achievement (high school record, course selection, standardized test scores) and well-developed talents in areas such as the arts, athletics, leadership, and service. We value ethnic, experiential, and geographic diversity; we expect appreciation and respect for the Honor Code. We consider a broad range of achievement, recognizing that excellence comes in many forms.

The Davidson Trust reflects the college's long-standing commitment to the principle that a Davidson education should be affordable for all students, independent of their ability to pay the cost of attendance. At Davidson, 100 percent of calculated financial need is met with a combination of grants and student employment. Financial aid packages include no loan component. Families may still choose to take out loans as a matter of personal financing.

Our application is designed to help us know you as an individual, as well as to give you insight into the qualities we seek in Davidson students. Part I of the application is attached to this letter. You may download Part II of the application from our website. Part II will ask you to answer essay questions, list academic experiences and extracurricular activities, and submit references from people who know you well. We urge you to complete your application materials honestly, thoroughly, and on time.

Our staff is eager to help you know Davidson and to assist you in the application process. Please feel free to call us with questions or concerns. Each member of our counseling staff is responsible for applicants in a specific region of the country, and you will be referred to the appropriate staff person when you call.

GETTING STARTED

- Return Part I—Davidson Admission Application and \$50 application fee or fee waiver request.
- Part II (Information & Essays, Secondary School Report, and Recommendations) available from our website.

OR

- Complete the Common Application and Supplement or the Coalition Application and any additional materials, and submit the \$50 application fee or fee waiver request.

AND

- SAT or ACT required (Davidson CEEB #5150; Davidson ACT #3086).
- TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) or IELTS (International English Language Testing System) required if **English is not your native language**.

EARLY DECISION PLANS

Postmark deadlines for completion of entire application: Early Decision I – November 15; Early Decision II – January 2

- Early Decision agreement is included with Part II.
The agreement states:
 - Davidson is definitely your first choice.*
 - You will not apply Early Decision to another college or university.*
 - If accepted, you will enroll at Davidson.*
 - If accepted, you will withdraw all applications to other colleges and universities.*
- SAT or ACT taken no later than: October for Early Decision I; December for Early Decision II.
- Admission notification letters mailed: mid-December for Early Decision I and late January for Early Decision II.

REGULAR DECISION PLAN

Postmark deadline for completion of entire application: January 7

- SAT or ACT taken no later than December.
- Admission notification letters mailed by April 1.

NEED-BASED FINANCIAL AID

Early Decision I and II

- By November 15: File College Scholarship Service (CSS)/Financial Aid PROFILE (Early Decision I).
- In December: Early Decision I financial aid notification letters mailed.
- By January 2: File College Scholarship Service (CSS)/Financial Aid PROFILE (Early Decision II).
- In February: Early Decision II financial aid notification letters mailed.
- By April 15: File Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Submit all completed tax documents (1040, W-2, etc.) to the College Board IDOC Service.

Regular Decision

- By February 15: File College Scholarship Service (CSS)/Financial Aid PROFILE.
- By February 15: File Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- By February 15: Submit all completed tax documents (1040, W-2, etc.) to the College Board IDOC Service.
- In March and April: Regular Decision financial aid notification letters mailed.
